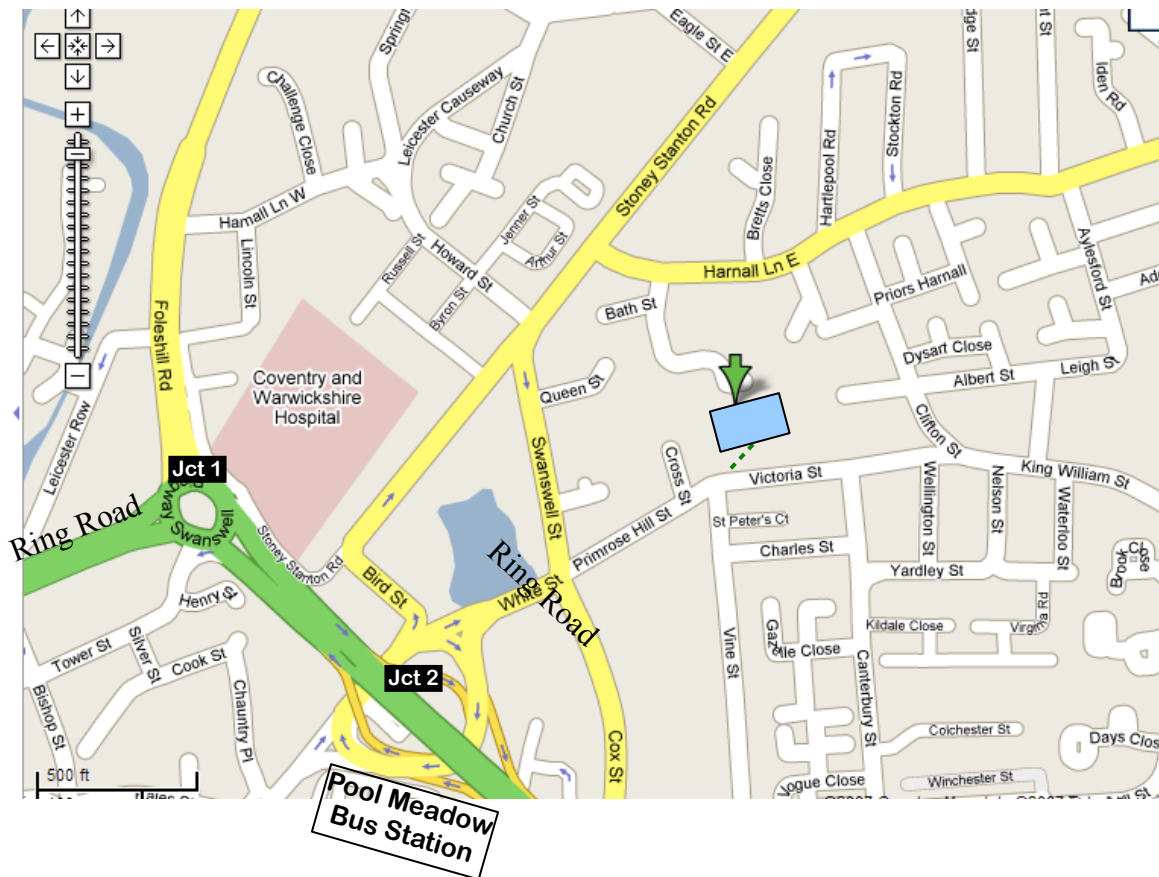


Below is a map to our offices at 6 Paul Stacey House, Bath Street, Coventry, CV1 5GU
The green arrow shows the location of Paul Stacey House, which is a tall block of flats.



Walking from Harnall Lane East: The front door of Paul Stacey House faces Bath Street, but our office is round at the back of the block. It is the only door on that side, and it has a ramp leading up to it, and a sign with “Welcome” in several languages.

Walking from the Primrose Hill Street / Victoria Street side: There's a pedestrian route (the dotted green line on the map) that heads our way from opposite the junction with Vine Street. The path has a temporary white wall to its left. When you get near Paul Stacey House, look for the wide gap in the green fencing. Our office is through the gap and straight in front of you. It is the only door on that side, with a ramp leading up to it, and a sign with “Welcome” in several languages.

Driving from outside Coventry: Follow signs for the City Centre until you reach the ring road. You can travel round the ring road in either direction – it is two miles long, and takes five minutes to go all the way around. Leave the ring road at Junction 2 (labelled as such on road signs), initially following signs for Bell Green and Coventry & Warwickshire Hospital, but moving one lane right as you pass under the elevated ring road to follow signs to Hillfields. Straight through the traffic lights and you'll be coming up Primrose Hill Street – park and see walking directions above.

Parking can be tricky, especially in the daytime during the week. In the evenings and at weekends, there's usually space in the side roads off Victoria Street. Otherwise, leave some time to find somewhere to park.

From the railway station: No 27 bus goes to Pool Meadow. Walk under the ring road, and carry straight on, past a pool in a park on your left, to Primrose Hill Street. Or show a taxidriver this map.
